C) Late Submissions/Arrival

Responses to the Preparatory Learning Module questions submitted past the stated due date will be considered LATE. Completion of Part 1 and Part 2 is required to be able to attend the remote/synchronous session; otherwise, the student will not be permitted to attend their session.
